- **2. C.** *Family* and *area* are common nouns and should not be capitalized. **See Lesson: Nouns.**
- **3. A.** *Knives* is the plural form of knife. *Salmon* is a non-count noun, so it does not have a plural form. **See Lesson: Nouns.**
- **4. B.** Her is a possessive pronoun. **See Lesson: Pronouns.**
- **5. B.** The relative pronoun *who* introduces a clause that gives more information about the noun *Mrs. Sato.* **See Lesson: Pronouns.**
- **6. B.** You is the only pronoun listed. **See Lesson: Pronouns.**
- **7. D.** *First* is an adjective that describes the noun *house*. **See Lesson: Adjectives and Adverbs.**
- **8. C.** The adjectives *new, tall,* and *modern* describe the noun *building*. **See Lesson: Adjectives and Adverbs.**
- **9. B.** The adverb *well* describes the verb *did*. **See Lesson: Adjectives** and **Adverbs.**
- **10. C.** *And* is a conjunction. **See Lesson: Conjunctions and Prepositions.**
- **11. C.** *In* is a preposition. **See Lesson: Conjunctions and Prepositions.**
- **12. C.** At is a preposition. **See Lesson: Conjunctions and Prepositions**



- **13. D.** *Are* is not the correct helping verb to form a question with *take*. *Do* is the correct helping verb, and *will* and *can*can also be used because they are modals. **See Lesson: Verbs and Verb Tenses.**
- **14. B.** Ask is the main verb. **See Lesson: Verbs and Verb Tenses.**
- **15. B.** *Traveled* is the only verb in the sentence. **See Lesson: Verbs and Verb Tenses.**
