5. C. The meaning of <u>hatch</u> in this context is "to create or produce an idea in a secret way." The word "plan" helps you figure out which



meaning of <u>hatch</u> is being used. See Lesson: Context Clues and Multiple Meaning Words.

6. B. The meaning of <u>exuberant</u> in the context of this sentence is "cheerful." **See Lesson: Context Clues and Multiple Meaning Words.**

7. A. Assertive has a positive connotation. See Lesson: Synonyms, Antonyms, and Analogies.

8. A. A pediatrician is an example of a doctor in the same way that a harp is an example of an instrument. **See Lesson: Synonyms, Antonyms, and Analogies.**
